The table in Figure 1 represents the numbers of working-age adults (in millions) who have each type of difficulty or impairment defined in the survey.



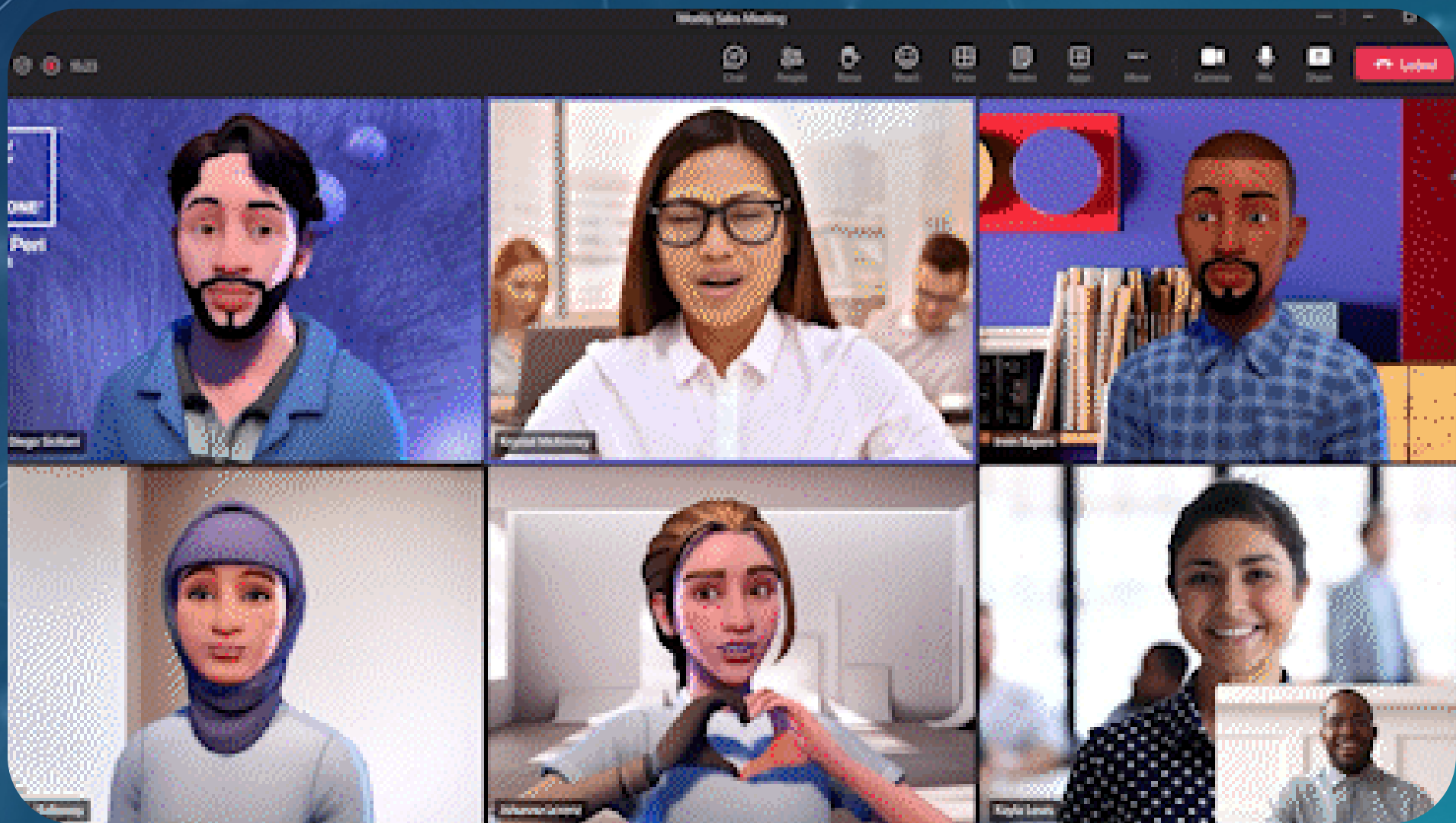

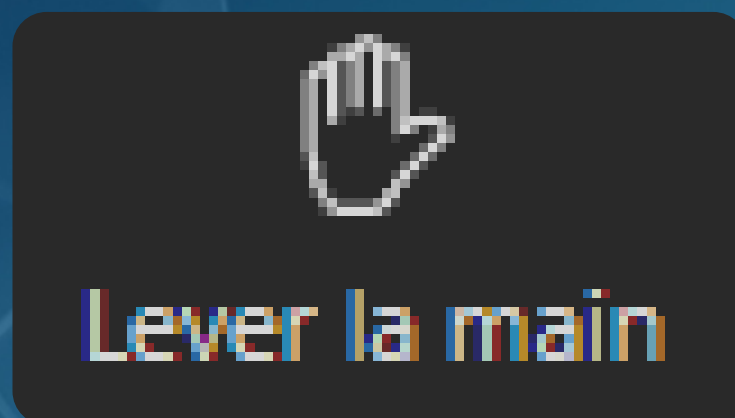
